The vehicle restraint system 84XEA.3_8 is embedded 4 cm in asphalt or concrete and is mainly used, where a high containment level is needed within a narrow space.

The installation of short barrier sections is possible due to a short minimum installation length. The system is also available with drainage openings.

The integrated, innovative coupling does not contain any loose parts. This does not only enhance the safety, but also the installation speed. The easy installation, which does not depend on weather conditions, reduces the disruptions of the traffic flow.

Thanks to the interlocking coupling, there are no loose parts, which prevent unauthorized removal of pieces and protects fully against vandalism.

The system REBLOC 84XEA.3_8 can also be installed backfilled.
